👑 TEN DAY ECONOMY TOUR 👑

DAY 1: Morning: Arrival in Scotland. You're met by a Tour Manager and taken by luxury transport to the Queens Hotel in Gullane (3 Nights) Afternoon: Play GULLANE #1*, one of the earliest 18 hole courses. Known for the staggering beauty of its almost 360° views of the Scottish countryside. Like playing in heaven.

DAY 2: Morning: Play MUIRFIELD, possibly the finest, most beautiful Open Championship course, the jewel in the linksland crown.

DAY 3: Morning: Play DUNBAR LINKS*, the legendary sleeping ground of Sir Oliver Cromwell's soldiers the night before the Battle of Dunbar. Afternoon: Play NORTH BERWICK WEST*, a favourite of the Lords & Ladies.

DAY 4: Morning: Play the beautiful, tree-lined fairways of LONGNIDRY. Afternoon: Play MUSSELBURGH OLD 9 (Optional), the oldest golf course still in play. Walk in the footsteps of Kings and Queens. Then, travel to the Sandford Hotel. (3 Nights)

DAY 5: Morning: Play SCOTTSCRAIG*, the 13th oldest course in Scotland. Afternoon: Go shopping in the town of St. Andrews.

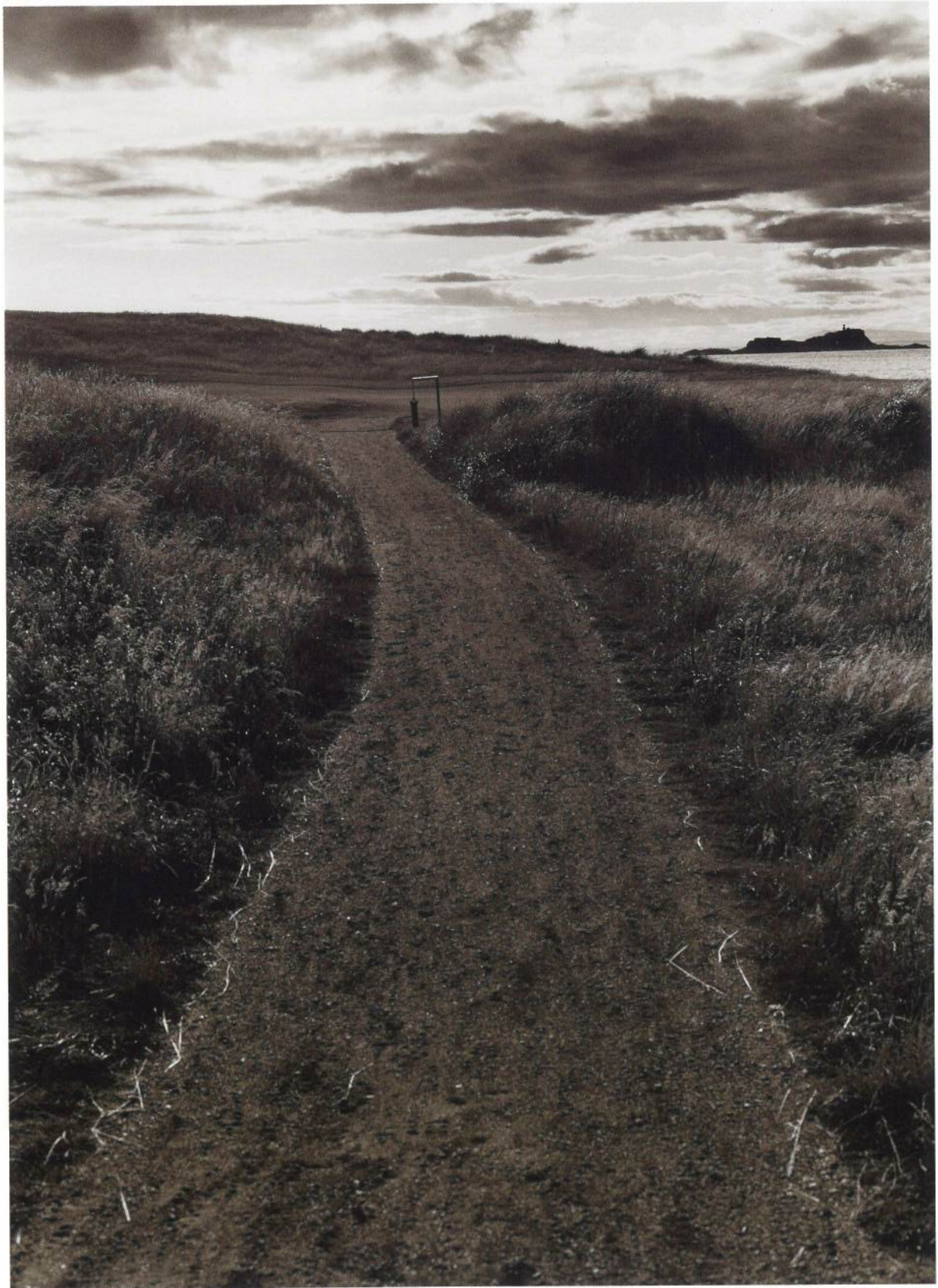
DAY 6: Morning: Play ST. ANDREWS NEW*, and feel the history all around you. Afternoon: Play ST. ANDREWS OLD (depending on the ballot). You're walking the same hallowed ground trod upon by Old Willie Park and Old Tom Morris, and the legions of legends who followed.

DAY 7: Morning: Play CARNOUSTIE, an unbelievable challenge. This is the course where Ben Hogan won the Open in 1953 and changed the face of modern golf forever. Afternoon: Travel to the North Beach Hotel (3 Nights)

DAY 8: Morning: Play PRESTWICK ST. NICHOLAS*, one of the oldest and most celebrated courses in the linksland. History from tee to green. Afternoon: Play PRESTWICK, where 24 Open Championships have been played, including the first in 1860.

DAY 9: Morning: Play ROYAL TROON (lunch included) The setting for many of golfing's greatest battles for the British Open. Afternoon: Play TROON PORTLAND*, a great test of one's mettle, with grand views of the islands of Aran and Ailsa.

DAY 10: Morning: Depart Scotland for your home country or add on to your tour.

DAY 5: Transfer to Russacks Hotel, St. Andrews (3 Nights)

Play one of ST. ANDREWS* illustrious courses. Non-golfers visit historic woolen mill and shopping areas. Followed by dinner.

DAY 6: Play CARNOUSTIE

Non-golfers visit Clamis Castle, childhood home of the Queen Mother. Then, dinner.

DAY 7: Play SCOTSCRAIG*

Non-golfers visit Scone Palace, Blair Castle, and their extraordinary gardens. Followed by dinner.

DAY 8: Transfer to Turnberry Hotel (2 Nights)

Play PRESTWICK, home of the first Open Championship. Non-golfers visit Culzean Castle. Then, dinner.

DAY 9: Play THE AISLA (TURNBERRY)

Non-golfers visit Glasgow, grand city of culture, sightseeing and shopping. Followed by dinner.

R E S E R V A T I O N S

A deposit of 50% of chosen tour per person (payable in sterling) is required within 14 days of confirmation. Balance of total cost is due 60 days prior to travel. Total cost of the tour is not guaranteed until payment in full has been received by M.G. Tours.

D O C U M E N T A T I O N

A current passport is required of all U.S. and Canadian citizens. Citizens of other countries should check with the British Embassy. If you require a rented vehicle (on an independent tour) you must have a current driver's license and be 21 years of age.

C A N C E L L A T I O N S

Notification of cancellation must be forwarded in writing to M.G. Tours as soon as possible. If any trip is cancelled by the company, all deposits and payments will be refunded in full. Otherwise cancellation charges will apply as follows to each traveler:

- 60 days or more prior to arrival: £150
- 59-21 days prior to arrival: 50% of total cost
- 20-6 days prior to arrival: 75% of total cost
- 5 days or less: No refund
